

# Washington County Rapid Fitness to Proceed Program (Rapid FtP) Metrics January 1<sup>st</sup> - December 31<sup>st</sup> 2022

## 39 SUCCESSFUL FITNESS DETERMINATIONS<sup>1</sup>

Rapid Fitness to Proceed Timeline	Regular .365 Order Timeline
Median time to determination: 16 days <sup>2</sup>	Median time to determination: 62 day <sup>3</sup>
Longest time to determination: 77 days	Longest time to determination: 139 days
Shortest time to determination: 7 days	Shortest time to determination: 23 days

- Rapid Ftp program jail savings on median timeline: 46 days of jail saved per defendant
- Jail costs: \$264.78/day<sup>4</sup>
- 46 days x 264.78/day = \$12,179.388 in jail costs saved.
- 39 defendants x 46 days at a cost of \$264.78 = \$475,015.32 in jail costs saved.

1. A successful fitness to proceed determination means that the evaluator was able to reach an opinion on the defendant's fitness to proceed.
2. Calendar days calculated from date records release order was submitted until the court made a determination of fitness or defense withdrew motion to determine fitness.
3. Calendar days calculated from date .365 order was submitted until the court made a determination of fitness or defense withdrew motion to determine fitness. In this calculation, we excluded defendants who required a 30 day observation period for whom the fitness to proceed determination regularly took 100 days or more.
